

0% ENERGY LOANS

SELCO is now offering 0% interest electrification and efficiency loans for owner-occupied homes or condos. These loans are available for the installation of HVAC heat pumps (air or ground), solar, service upgrades, energy-efficient replacement windows, and doors or additional insulation.

CONNECTED HOMES

Connected Homes is a program offered to customers of Shrewsbury Electric and Cable Operations (SELCO) that leverages the technology of smart appliances and devices into cost savings for customers. The program allows SELCO to better manage its electric load, reduce costs, and keep rates low.

By enrolling a smart device in the Connected Homes Program, customers agree to allow Connected Homes to make brief, limited adjustments to their devices during times of peak electric demand, such as temporarily turning off an electric vehicle charger during peak hours.

Enrolled customers will receive from \$5 to \$15 each month for each enrolled eligible device.
